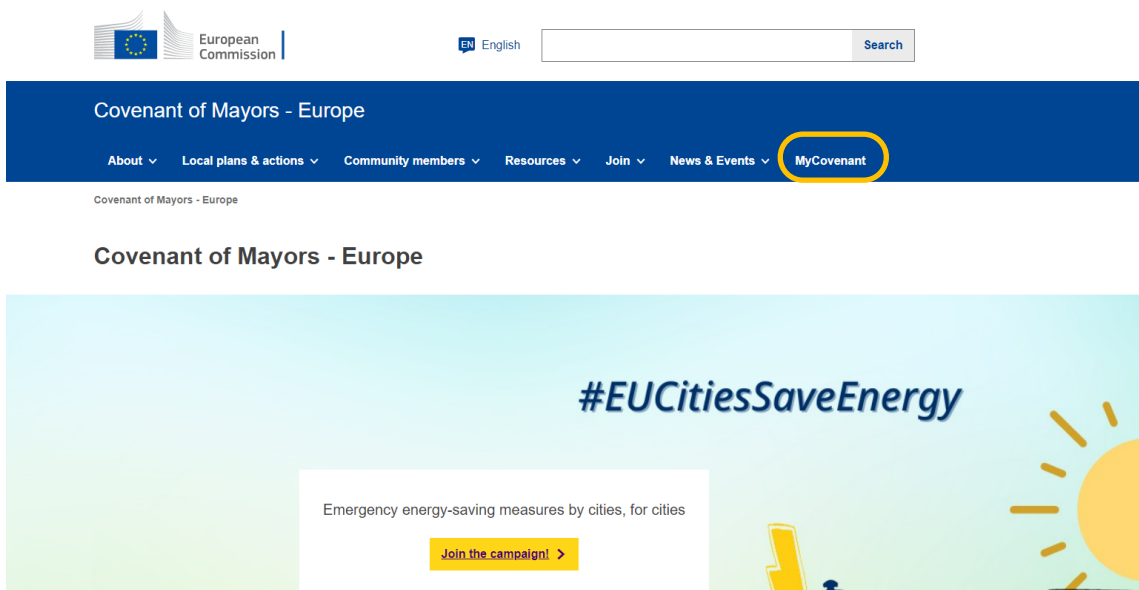

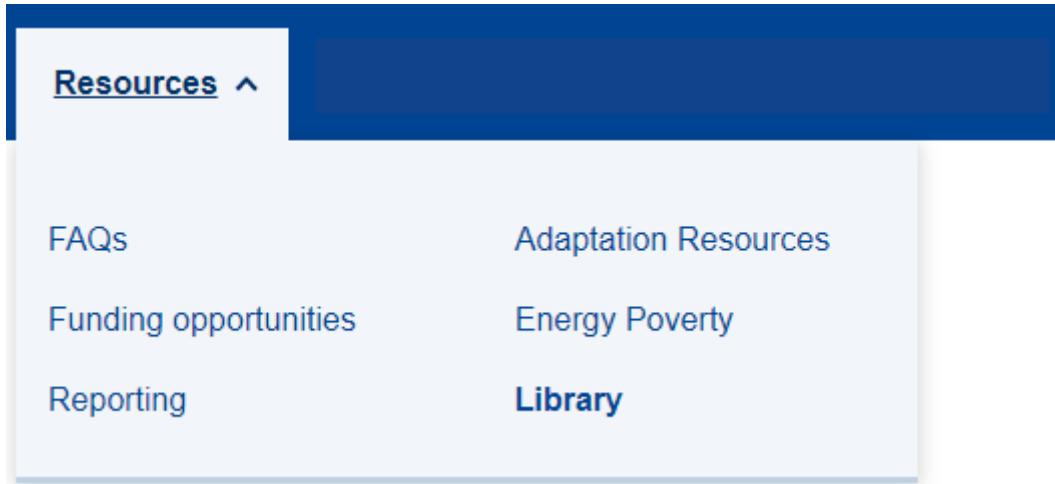



The dashboard is divided into several key sections:

This is the dashboard of MyCovenant. Here, you have access to all the sections and features offered by the platform.

The dashboard shows the contacts associated with your organization (Mayor and Main Contact person), the achieved Covenant badges and your Covenant status. It also gives you access to your MyCovenant Community, the Reporting Corner and the Capacity Sharing Corner.



In the central part of the dashboard, you can find the basic information on your organization: country, population, the type of adhesion, and the contact details of the mayor and of the main contact person (5).

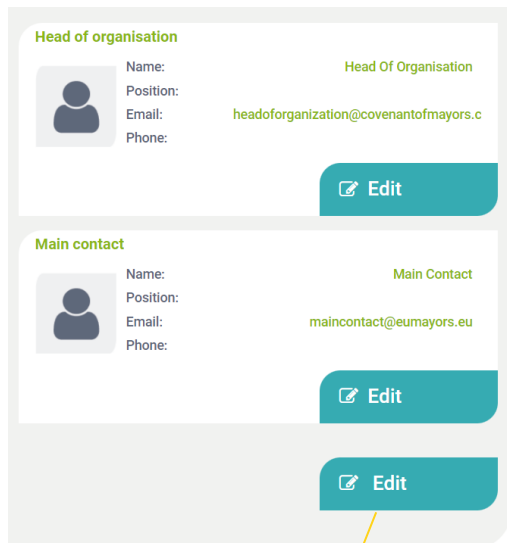
Remember that you can change the language of the platform at any time (6), selecting it among the 24 EU official languages.

Within the Covenant of Mayors – Europe initiative, signatories commit to cutting their GHG emissions (mitigation pillar), increasing their resilience to climate change (adaptation pillar) and tackle energy poverty (energy poverty pillar).

Once your local authority successfully submits an action plan, it is rewarded with the **Global Covenant of Mayor badges**, which are updated every time a milestone is reached.

These badges are assigned in line with the [Common Reporting Framework](#) of the Global Covenant of Mayors.





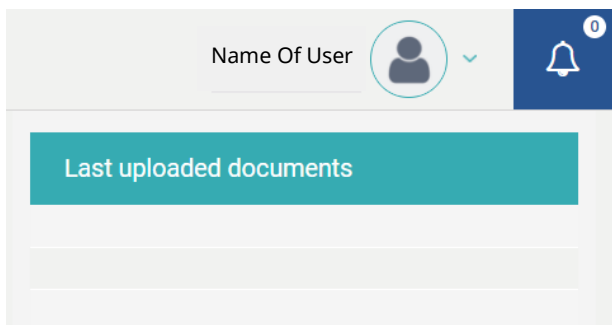
By clicking on the related **Edit** button, you can modify the contact profile of the Head of the Organisation and the Main Contact person.

By clicking on the **Edit (7)** button at the bottom, you can add new contacts, and in case of staff changes, modify existing profiles or delete the obsolete ones.

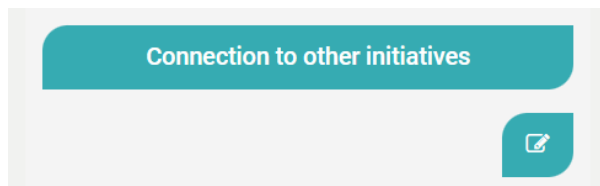

The table “Commitments” show the Covenant of Mayors steps:

-  **CoM 2020** aimed at signatories committing to mitigation targets to 2020. It is no longer possible to join this step.
-  The **Mayors Adapt** initiative no longer exists. Former Mayors Adapt signatories automatically joined the Covenant of Mayors – Europe when the two initiatives merged back in 2014.
-  **CoM 2030** refers to the Covenant of Mayors – Europe path launched in October 2015 (with a GHG reduction target of 40% by 2030).
-  **CoM 2050** refers to the latest Covenant of Mayors – Europe chapter launched on the 21<sup>st</sup> of April 2021 (with the objective of reaching climate neutrality by 2050). Learn more [here](#).

What are the ...?

**Covenant coordinators** are national, regional and sub-regional public authorities that are in a position to provide strategic guidance, technical and financial support to Covenant of Mayors signatories in their territory.

To add a Covenant Coordinator to your profile, you just need to click the + sign and select from a drop-down menu the organization you want to add.



NB: Connecting Coordinators to a signatory's profile allows them to **access data** and have an overview on the progress achieved by the signatory.

**Covenant supporters** are associations of local authorities, European networks, thematic local and regional agencies, and not-profit organisations with the capacity to promote the Covenant of Mayors and to mobilise and support their members and/or local authorities to attain the Covenant of Mayors - Europe objectives.

When adding Supporters to your profile you can select whether you give them access to your reporting corner or not. If you select “Without access to reporting corner” then they can only visualise your profile.

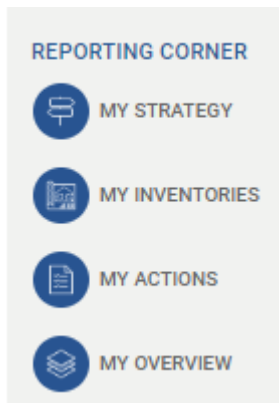

## MY AIR QUALITY TOOL ASSESSMENT



This tool is always available if you have your Baseline Emission Inventory (BEI) and at least one Monitoring Emission Inventory (MEI) submitted. Here you will be able to select your reported BEI and MEI, and the pollutants to be considered in the analysis.

Click on “Submit” to run the tool. The results’ page will appear, containing a full explanation of the indicators, the tables and the plots proposed.

### Air Quality Tool - BETA VERSION

Tool for analysing air quality consequences associated with energy and GHG emission reported by signatories.

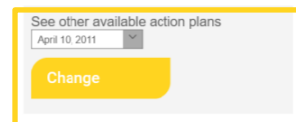
