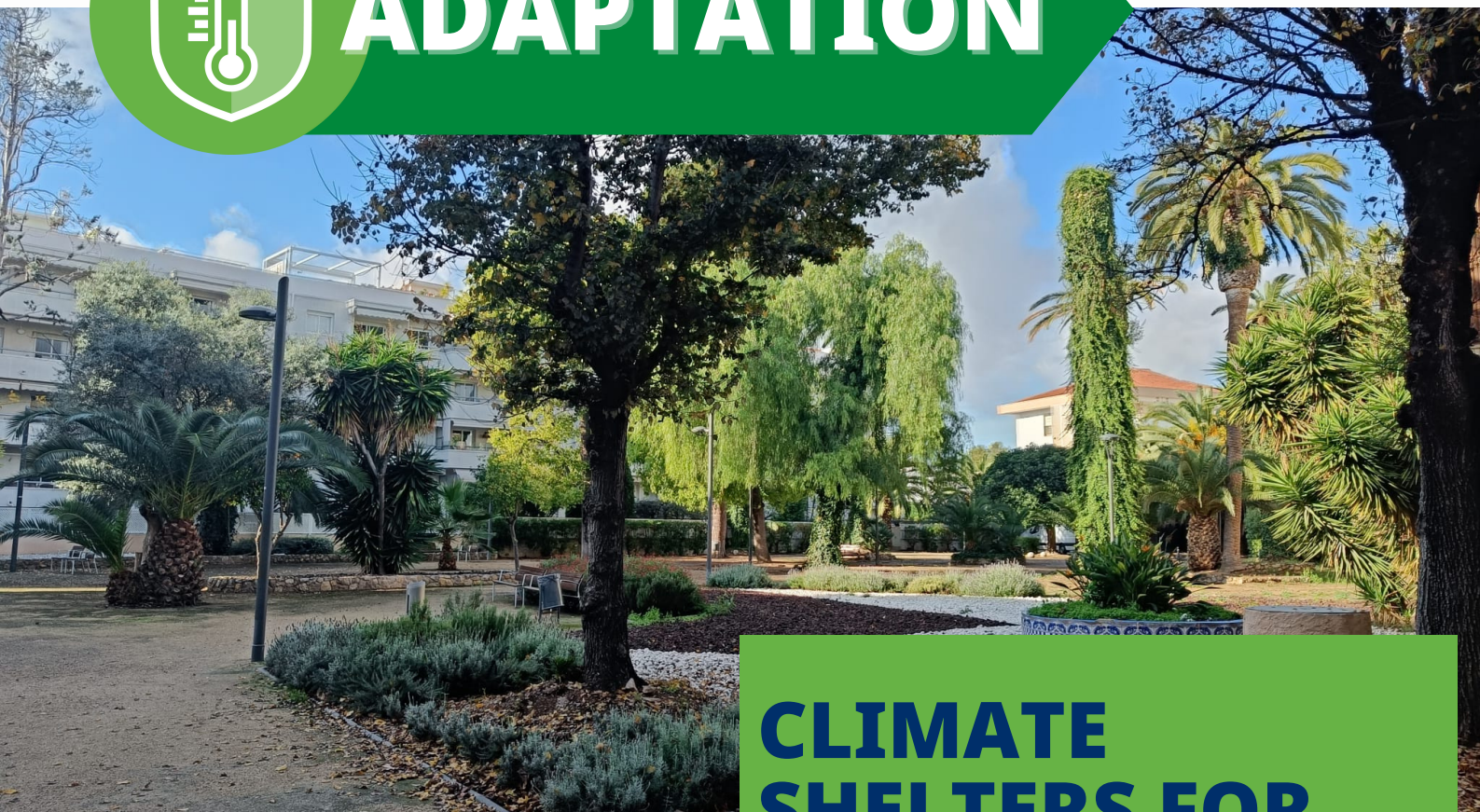

Sitges has opened several public buildings as climate shelters during this summer. Moreover, a public square will be equipped with a shadowing system to be more comfortable for community members. Finally, the SECAP will soon be approved, and the new local government has a strong commitment to its implementation.
