What is the Covenant of Mayors for Climate and Energy?

The Covenant of Mayors for Climate & Energy is the world's largest movement for local climate and energy action. In Europe, we bring together over 10,000 cities and towns, who are joining forces to secure a better future for their citizens.

Embedded in the EU's climate and energy policy framework, the Covenant is a nonlegislative initiative that aims to work alongside the European Green Deal policy package. Our vision is that, by 2050, all Europeans will be living in decarbonised and resilient cities with access to affordable, secure and sustainable energy. To achieve this, the participating municipalities pledge to:

- (1) reduce greenhouse gas emissions on their territory
- (2) increase resilience and prepare for the adverse impacts of climate change
- (3) tackle energy poverty as one key action to ensure a just transition.
